

About the Variety Trials:

These trials, conducted at three in-state locations: Virginia Beach, Chesapeake, and Westmoreland County, are funded by an integrated, internal competitive grant from VAES, VCE and the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Virginia Tech. The trials are being conducted under the supervision of Dr. Jayesh Samtani, Small Fruit Production Specialist. Hampton Roads AREC, in collaboration with Dr. Chuck Johnson, Plant Pathologist, Southern Piedmont AREC, and Dr. Jeremy Pattison from NCSU. There are twelve varieties planted in three replications, with 20 to 30 plants/replicates. In addition to the variety trials, you can also look at plantings of 'Ovation' and 'Honeoye'. Picked berries will be available for tasting.
