### The Historic Natural Bridge Hotel and Conference Center

The Natural Bridge Park Historic Hotel is an iconic centerpiece in Americana. A replacement hotel to the original Natural Bridge Hotel which caught fire on April 24, 1963 and was completely burned to the ground, a new hotel was built in 1964 and is the one that stands ready and waiting for your arrival.

Come enjoy a balcony view of the gorgeous Blue Ridge Mountains, sip wine on the veranda, enjoy a cool morning hike, take in the spectacle of our 500 million year old natural bridge, and step back in time and experience a truly one of a kind experience that is found nowhere else on this earth.

The Natural Bridge property is managed by the Virginia Conservation Legacy Fund, a nonprofit devoted to conservation, education, and recreation. Natural Bridge hosts 150,000 visitors per year and is expected to host over 1 million per year in the future. Education is a primary goal at Natural Bridge focusing on bridge history, caverns, archaeology, geology, and ecology. The Monacan Indian Living History outdoor museum is continuing to develop and offers Virginia SOL compliant programs for students.

Natural Bridge is located between Lexington and Roanoke, Virginia, and is just off the Blue Ridge Parkway and I-81. The Natural Bridge Park Historic Hotel has 152 rooms offered in three different styles of rooms, fifteen cottages, approximately 10,000 square feet of meeting space, and a 150-seat full service Colonial Dining Room offering breakfast and dinner each day. The hotel paired with it's endless amount of activities onsite at Natural Bridge Park is the perfect place for family vacations, reunions, business meetings, special events, and weddings.
