**RE:** Northern District 4-H Livestock Judging Contest

**LOCATION:** Rockingham County Fairgrounds

The 2016 Northern District 4-H Livestock Judging Contest will be held on Saturday, May 14, 2016 beginning at 9:00 AM. All Virginia counties with 4-H Livestock Programs are invited to participate in this event. Enclosed you will find information on rules and regulations, fees, registration information, and a tentative schedule.

All contestants should come prepared to evaluate classes of Beef Cattle, Sheep, Swine and Goats (subject to change due to the availability of livestock). Market and breeding classes will be offered in each species. Data on the individual classes will be provided whenever possible, and should be used in determining the final placing and answering questions. This is a learning and educational contest, therefore some guidance may be given by committee members approval during the contest.

Senior age level participants (14 to 19 years old as of 09/30/16) will give one set of oral reasons for each species. Junior age level participants (9 to 13 years old as of 09/30/16) will be expected to give one set of oral reasons on a class and species to be named the day of the contest. Participants who have not turned 14 as of January 1, 2016 but, will turn 14 on or before September 30, 2016 are eligible to compete as JUNIORS. To do this, simply enter them as a junior or with a junior team. All participants will be responsible for answering questions relating to individual classes. The answers will be scored and included in the overall scores.

An individual participant fee <u>for all registered participants</u> will be assessed to cover the awards and meal expenses. For all contestants, this fee is \$13.00 per individual. Lunch is included. Contestants may not leave the grounds for lunch. <u>Anyone whose registration is postmarked after May 6, 2016 will pay \$15.00 per individual.</u>
No teams will be accepted and refunds will not be given after May 11<sup>th</sup>.

# **Rules and Regulations**

- 1. Members must be enrolled in a 4-H program in the unit they represent.
- 2. Senior level participants must be 14 to 19 years old as of 09/30/16.
- 3. Junior level participants must be 9 to 13 years old as of 09/30/16. Participants who are not 14 as of January 1, 2015 but will turn 14 on or before September 30, 2016 are eligible to compete as a junior.
- 4. A team can consist of 3 or 4 members. On a 4-person team, the lowest individual score will be dropped when totaling team scores. All team members are eligible for individual awards.
- 5. No talking or sharing of notes, pens, or pencils between participants will be allowed during the contest. Violators will be warned one time, then the individual will be disqualified.
- 6. There is no limit on the number of participants or teams per unit.
- 7. Any discrepancies must be brought to the attention of the contest Co-Chairperson in writing and will be resolved according to State 4-H Guidelines.
- 8. No teams will be accepted and refunds will not be given after May 11<sup>th</sup>.
- 9. Lunch will be provided and if there are any special needs, please contact the Rockingham County Extension Office by May 6. Contestants may not leave the grounds for lunch. For parents and coaches, lunch will be \$7.00 and please include parent/coach lunches on registration summary sheet.

## **Awards**

Ribbons and Plaques will be awarded to Junior and Senior teams and individuals for placings in individual species, overall, and reasons.
