What is my4-H?



Next Generation my4-H serves as a central and collaborative source for more of the 4-H resources you want –including the National Directory of 4-H Materials. 4-H professionals, volunteers and even youth leaders, from anywhere, can upload, download, comment, even rank local, state and nationally produced 4-H resources on my4-H.

Whether it's training staff at a state-wide event or supporting volunteers with project materials, my4-H is the tool for effectively engaging an audience around resources important to them, and to you. Next Generation my4-H focuses on sharing 4-H resources which was identified as our users' top need. The site operates in an open community format allowing teens to engage as full partners in sharing and rating resources, as well as in the open discussions.

How can my4-H work for you?

Share. Upload your 4-H-related resources to my4-H. Tag them with keywords for easy searching. Resources on my4-H receiving state approval are searchable by Land Grant University and bring recognition to your state's 4-H youth development program.

Discuss. my4-H paves the way for open dialog among the 4-H community, no matter your location or 4-H affiliation. Discover new programming ideas, ask questions and share your experiences with other 4-H professionals and volunteers around the corner or across the country.

Learn. Explore new 4-H programming ideas, gain new perspectives and strengthen your own understanding about topics most relevant to your 4-H work. Getting engaged on my4-H ensures the learning continues long after the formal training ends.

Features of my4-H!

Simplified Log-in – Log-in with just a username (email) & password.

Upload Resources – Share files or links of 4-H-related resources. If it's helpful to you, it will be helpful to someone else.

Download Resources – No need to reinvent the wheel. Save time by finding resources important and useful to you.

Personalized Tagging – Searching is made easy when you add your event or your own unique identifying tag to your resources, or someone else's resources.

Basic Search – Quickly locate resources of interest based on resource title, description or any given tags.

Advanced Search - Customize your resource search using an expanded taxonomy.

Download Counter – Monitor resource demand with a running total of downloads.

Resource Rating – Provide feedback using the five-star rating system.

Comments – Expand your feedback or request insight as the conversation continues around a resource.

Plus, DISCUSSIONS – Any logged in user can start or reply to a topic. Ask a question or join a discussion.
