What are the criteria for material submitted into the National Directory of 4-H Educational Materials?

- Material created or revised within the past 7 years.
- Material created within a land grant university system, intended either for a youth audience or for adults working with youth.
- Material can be identified in one of the 4 categories of 4-H materials: 4-H Project Curriculum; 4-H Curriculum for Groups; 4-H Volunteer/Professional Development Materials; 4-H Resources. To learn more about the 4 categories of materials go to: <http://www.4-hdirectory.org/about>

How can I submit material into the National Directory of 4-H Educational Materials?
